REGULATIONS

Attendance, In-Class Rules, and Dress Code

- There will be no make-up classes
- Child might be re-assigned to another class by the teacher at any time during school.
- No food or drinks (except water) is allowed in the studio
- Hair must be neatly pulled back in a bun and be done prior to arrival (if hair is short: pin back bangs and use a hair band)
- Jewellery (e.g. dangly earrings, necklaces, bracelets) are not permitted in class for safety reasons
- Tardy students must get permission to join the class. If the class is well in progress, the instructor may refuse permission on the grounds that improper incomplete warm-ups could lead to injury
- Proper attire is required for every class. Students arriving without a proper dress code may be asked to leave the class
